I hope everyone is having a very happy (and occasionally sunshine filled) summer.

As I'm sure you know, summer is typically one of the busiest times of the year for public libraries. As Summer Reading kicks into full gear, our libraries are visited by parents and children enjoying their breaks and their precious free time.

Librarians in the late 1800s recognized that in the summer months library use skyrocketed and lighter fiction reigned supreme as a preferred summer genre, and this is still mostly true today. However, leveraging public library busy-ness to help solve one of education's trickiest problems, the dreaded "summer slide", is a modern library innovation.

This year's Summer Reading theme, "Reading by Design", is a riff on recent educational trends incorporating STEAM (science, technology. engineering, art, mathematics), principles in classrooms, and inspired by the creativity of authors, illustrators, builders, inventors, artists, architects, and everyone who makes our world a more interesting, livable, accessible, and beautiful place (http://www.ireadprogram.org).

If you'd like your own inspiration for summer learning, take a look at some of the library's amazing programs over the summer. While most are geared for children and families, these programs show the creativity and dedication of our staff as we are coping with more patrons and reduced staffing levels.

### GIFTS TO THE LIBRARY 2016/17

During the fiscal year ending June 30 the Friends' gifts to the Library totaled \$32,108. Of that amount \$27,580 was provided for the purchase of books and other library materials. \$1,740 was used for professional development expenses connected to the Annual Conference of the California Library Association. \$605 paid for licensing for the movies shown in the *Based on the Book* series, \$669 provided an online cataloging reference tool, and \$764 was used for supplies and equipment. \$600 supported the Summer Reading Program and \$150 provided support for the very successful Harry Potter celebration.

In addition to these gifts the Friends, as a founding sponsor, continued to provide our annual support of \$1,500 to the Humboldt County Children's Author Festival.

Funds for these gifts came from book store and internet sales as well as our quarterly sales, memberships above the basic level, and donations, including memorial donations. We are grateful to all our Friends and to others who helped to make our continued support of the Library possible.


### **AUTHOR FESTIVAL NEWS**




