### **MICHAEL LOGAN RETIRES AFTER 36 YEARS**



December 22nd marked Michael Logan's last day as a member of the Library staff, a position he first held in 1987. After being hired as a page in March of that year while finishing up his BA at Humboldt State, he advanced to a position of Library Clerk in the Circulation Department on a part-time basis that December. He became a full-time staff member in 1989, remaining in that position until he transferred to the Technical Services Department as a Library Assistant in 1995. In 2001 he was promoted to Senior Library Assistant.

Michael's interest in film led him to found in 2005, with Cindy Denbo, the Library's very popular *Based on the Book* classic film series. He had sole

responsibility for the series from 2007 until it was halted by the pandemic in 2020. During much of the same period he also served as a volunteer and board member with the Eureka Theater.

In 2007 Michael enrolled in the Master's program at San Jose State University while continuing his regular responsibilities with the Library, graduating with the MLS degree in 2012. In 2016 he became manager of the Library's Acquisitions and Technical Services Department, a position in which he served until his retirement.

## **NEWS FROM CHRIS COOPER, LIBRARY DIRECTOR**

On Thursday, December 28, 2023, Ana Jordan retired from the Humboldt County Library after more than 37 years of dedicated service.

Ana Jordan was born in Honduras, the daughter of Angel and Hilda Corral. She grew up in Humboldt County with one brother and five sisters. As a child her fondest memories were enjoying family picnics, and especially heading inland to warmer weather.

She started her career in administration and office management at Mission Economic Development Agency (MEDA) in San Francisco. In 1986, Ana filled out a job interest card with the county and was notified of the job opening with the library. She was interviewed by former Humboldt County Library Director Judy Klapproth and Assistant Director Lisa Naef, who informed her that it



would be a few weeks before she would hear from them. By the time she arrived home from her interview she had a message on her answering machine offering her the position. Ana's primary work at the library was offering administrative support for all branches of the Humboldt County Library system, accounts payable and receivable and payroll.

One story she remembers from her work life has stuck with her. "I am usually the first one in the building. I was working upstairs one morning and went down to the circulation workroom to put on coffee, only to find the fire department cutting into the children's room wall. No alarms went off since the fire was on the outside of the building. They were as surprised as I was to see them in the building!"

Ana has not only been our numbers person. She cares deeply about HCL staff and library partners. Ana would do whatever she could to help people with daily tasks and long-term support for grants, creative problem solving, and answering questions about library policies and procedures.

Ana has enjoyed the people she worked with, and those she met through associations, such as members of the Friends of the Redwood Libraries. Ana enjoyed the fast pace, and various responsibilities of her position. "There was always something that needed to be done."

Ana is someone who is a creative thinker, and is sensitive to life's many details—large and small. "My nieces say that I have everything that you could think of or might need in my closet, from wrist bracelets to birthday candles." About her creativity, Ana says, "I am a person that always has a project, knitting, crochet, cross stitching, etc. I enjoy staying up all night since it's the best time for me to focus on my projects.
